**Shopwithscrip.com**—Get a percentage back to the school for the shopping you're already doing. Sure, you can purchase standard gift cards, but you can also buy reloadable cards for many of the stores you frequent. After you buy your first card, you have the ability to quickly reload the card right on your phone in seconds, whenever you need, and a percentage goes back to the school. For example, if you spent \$100 at Bath & Body Works, SSPP would receive \$13, or if you're shopping online at the Nike store and you spend \$200, SSPP would receive \$24. You're spending the money anyways; why not make sure a portion makes it back to support our school?

**Schoolstore.com**—Make this your first stop before you do any online shopping! The first time you use the site, pick Saints Peter and Paul Catholic School, in Cary, IL, as your chosen school to receive your percentage back. Then browse the site for discounts or search for a specific store, click on it, and when you make a purchase from a shopping session that begins at Schoolstore.com, the stated percentage comes right back to SSPP. The site also offers student incentives and prizes for purchases of magazines, books, or Caring for the Classroom Donations, purchased through their site!

**Shoparoo.com**—This one is easy. Go to the website or search for their App on your smartphone, download it, and then take pictures of your receipts. They do the rest. Snap pictures of your receipts from any store, big or small, that sells grocery items to earn Roo Points (cash donations) for your school. Whether you're shopping at a supercenter, dollar store, or local convenience store - it doesn't matter where you shop or what items you buy - Shoparoo will make a cash donation for every receipt! Submit up to 20 grocery receipts within a rolling 7 day period. Or, snap pictures of your receipts from any restaurant or other retailer (that doesn't sell grocery items) to earn entries for your school into Shoparoo's \$1,000 monthly sweepstakes and \$15,000 yearly sweepstakes! Each receipt counts as an entry into both monthly and yearly sweepstakes, so spread the word at your school - the more receipts you submit, the greater your school's chance is of winning. Submit up to 50 non-grocery receipts within a rolling 7 day period.
